

**MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS – WESTLAKE BOYS HIGH SCHOOL 2011.
FREE BRASS LESSONS**

In order to encourage young musicians onto Band instruments earlier in their schooling, Westlake Boys High School is offering four Scholarships for Year 7/8 students who are intending to go to W.B.H.S. in 2012/13 and would like to begin either the French Horn or Trombone this year.

- This is a Music Tuition Scholarship where one of Westlake’s Itinerant music staff will come to T.N.I.S. once a week and tutor your son for half an hour on the instrument.
- The monetary value of the scholarship is \$1200 per student (approx 40 lessons per year).
- Students will need to hire the instrument (WBHS staff will help with this)
- Students must commit to attending W.B.H.S. and being involved in the Bands or Orchestras when they are a student there. Also they will be required to join the T.N.I.S. Orchestra when they are able to play to a basic standard. Failure to do this will require a refund of \$1000 to WBHS.
- Mr David Kay will be coming to T.N.I.S. in Week Two to demonstrate the instruments
